When a member of the **BCH** family was sidelined by a horrific motorcycle accident, the team came together to do whatever they could to make the recovery period a little less stressful for Steve Buron and his wife, Bonnie.

Steve Buron was enjoying a bike ride in October, but could not avoid the motorist that stopped in his lane. His life threatening injuries were so severe that he was airlifted to Blake Medical Center in Bradenton. Steve spent several weeks in intensive care, where he contracted pneumonia while fighting to recover from a broken neck, collarbone, and leg but he was motivated to get better and get out of that hospital. In a few short months, his recovery has been nothing short of miraculous.

When a co-worker learned that the Buron's A/C was out, **BCH** owners, Daryl Blume and Dan Allen, offered to provide the family with a new unit, covering the cost of equipment and materials. **BCH** team members Jeff Green, Steve Arena, Andy Harkin, Ryan Homan, and Kenny Thompson installed the unit, generously donating their time.

Joe Downs kept tabs on Steve's progress through daily phone calls from his wife Bonnie, and when he learned that Steve did not have enough personal days to cover what would be a lengthy leave, Joe organized an effort to contribute vacation days. Joe went on the jobsite, asked if anyone wanted to help out, and received an immediate positive response. "It's unbelievable how quickly everyone came together. In just a couple of days, we had collected 40 days of vacation time and some of those who didn't have extra time offered to give a gift of money to help with medical bills", Joe said. "Everyone in this story was absolutely unbelievable, stepping up for Steve while he was down".

Steve Buron has been a member of the BCH family since 2001 and works in production as a pipefitting foreman. He has already made great strides, coming to the office to assist on takeoffs for Northrop Grumman. He expects to rejoin the team in a full-time capacity in January, which even his doctors cannot believe. Congratulations to Steve on his hard fought road to recovery and his strong will to get back, and a heartfelt thanks to our team who always makes us proud—on and off the jobsite.

Jason Morris, General Manager of the North Carolina branch, has been there from the beginning. Once the



original owner retired, he took full control of the location, turning things around for the better. Jason has stepped up in a big way and his team has led the company service branch in several key matrixes to garner the first annual award. Tim Whitaker and Jackie Link are two of Jason's star performers, insuring that field and office operations run smoothly. Congratulations to Team North Carolina for a great year!
