#### A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRESIDENT

It's the time of year to start making goals for the upcoming year and reviewing accomplishments from the previous year. I have always found reviewing goals, set where we are, and documenting new goals, where we want to be, difficult and time-consuming. But the rewards of accomplishing what was put from pen to paper are well worth it. Staying focused on the goals written at the beginning of the year can be challenging, but constantly reviewing goals can help you achieve them. Not only did the team hit that goal, but it was surpassed very quickly, with us achieving over 6,000 near misses. This program helped our organization to reduce accidents and kept our employees from getting hurt. It was a significant culture change to be willing to tell what we were not doing right and the courage to know that the organization would not punish anyone but instead reward them for helping us get it right in the future.

The team helped create some learning opportunities on software and technology that significantly impacted the organization. This training not only included learning the software program better, but also involved us improving our processes. It required assistance from all aspects of the business to make it happenfrom the field to management, and even finance. We are very grateful for all the effort put in by everyone to have made such an impact with the training. We will keep exploring new technologies that will improve the productivity of our employees and make the arduous job a little easier.



This upcoming year, we will continue to push both training and safety. To improve on the foundations that we have already started on and to help those in organizations take even more significant steps forward in both being safe and job advancements. I cannot thank our team members enough for all their hard work last year and commitment to achieving larger goals and objectives. We genuinely have a best-in-class organization.

# SAFETY FIRST, SAFETY ALWAYS: - A MESSAGE FROM OUR SAFETY DIRECTOR, JEREMY BENDORF -

HAPPPY NEW YEAR! 2023 was a great year! We were able to perform some great trainings and make some tremendous strides in our safety culture. Did you know that we went from 700 NEAR MISS REPORTS IN 2022 TO 6,100 in 2023? This is huge! Every time a NEAR MISS is called in, it is proven to reduce incidents and accidents. We don't know how many lives we impacted through quality reporting, but for every 300 reported, statistics say we eliminate a severe incident. We also performed over 9,000 audits. Now these audits are not "gotcha moments". These were moments of awareness and coaching within our team, and we are all on the team. Our average score was a 96.7% out of 100, with only 1/10 reports needed a simple correction or adjustment and 1/100 with a hazard issue needing Safety Team involvement. This was an outstanding job by everyone. We are excited about 2024 and can't wait to keep moving towards our goal to ZERO.

Our goal is to make 2024 not only our best year but also our safest. We are striving for zero. This means every day and every decision counts. We need to attend and be part of our morning JHA meetings, attend our trainings and toolbox meetings and be the catalyst in our safety journey. We are confident that our employees are our greatest asset. BCH and ConServ understand the need to develop and enhance each employee's awareness of safety. Our goal is that each of you feel educated and empowered to make the safest choice every day, every time, everywhere for everyone.

January is a great time to refocus. Take a moment and clear our heads, gather our thoughts and push into a great year. We are confident in each professional on the team. Knowing that each of us have responsibility in our safety not just at work, but when we are driving and when we are at home.

**2024:** WORK SAFE - HOME SAFE - LIVE SAFE. If we do this, our journey to zero should be closer than we think. Let's make our 5x5's our best practice in 2024. If it doesn't look right, smell right or sound right, step back and look around, ask for assistance or input, and make the best and safest choice possible. Stop for a moment and perform a near miss report so we can learn and grow from each experience and exposure with the goal of eliminating hazards in the future.

The purpose of a near miss is to share knowledge and lessons learned with the rest of the team. It's sharing potential and current observations to prevent them as we move forward. It's not just about collecting the data. It's about using the data to make us stronger and more aware of the hazards that we work with daily. With knowledge of past experiences, we can move into a proactive and preventative posture in our safety. This is how we work safe, get home safe and live safe.
